OF - Kevin Persick (SR) League MVP

from Zachary, LA, senior to be at Nichols State, **League MVP**, batted .462 lead league in total hits, extra base hits, and RBI's. Did not commit an error defensively all summer

OF - Daryl Wesley (3S)

From LaPlace, LA, returns to Southern U for sophomore year, consistent dependable player that batted .289 for the season and came on strong to provide a dependable hitter in the middle of line-up for 3S Hitting in second half of the season

OF - Darren Bueche (3S)

From New Roads, LA, graduating senior from Catholic High of Pointe Coupee walked on to earn a starting spot in the collegiate league. Solid defensive centerfielder that hit .306 on the season.

3B - TJ Trantham (GL)

From Baton Rouge, La, returning to BRCC for sophomore season, do it all player for Gerry Lane that made his biggest impact in the infield, and committed only 1 defensive error on the summer. Lead the league in hitting for much of the season, finished with a .349 average from the lead off spot in the line-up. Runner up for league MVP.

SS - Josh Perez (3S)

From New Iberia, LA, two year star at BRCC moving on to MS College. Made eye popping plays from SS all summer. Finishing with a .938 fielding percentage and played every inning for 3S on the season. Batted a respectable .288 and was solid at the top of the 3S line-up with 7 Stolen bases.

2B - Thomas Willis (SR)

From St. Francisville, LA, Southern U, Thomas finished the summer with a .357 average, good for 4th in the league. Played both middle infield positions for Southern Recycling and maintain an above .500 on base percentage with only 4 K's on the summer.
